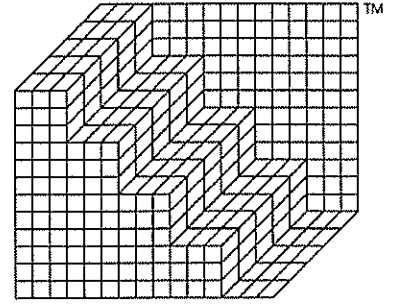

**RE: 10 TRINITY SQUARE, LONDON - ADDENDUM TO STRUCTURAL STRATEGY**  
**To be read in conjunction with Structural Strategy, November 2008**

Dear Alex

We are writing to you following the amendment to the planning submission for the development at 10 Trinity Square, London. We can confirm that the amendments are related to Seething Lane Garden and the structural implications are as follows:

-Pavilion to the North: This pavilion now houses the double vehicle lifts which have been moved from the South pavilion. The basement levels under the North pavilion require steel framing around the vehicle lifts and within the floor depth to provide sufficient restraint to the perimeter retaining walls. The basement is narrower at the North end so a higher quantity of steelwork is required.

-Pavilion to the South: The vehicle lifts are moved to the North as described above. The pavilion shape has changed and the core walls under are new.

For the above items the only change to our structural planning report is the revision to the page in Appendix 1 showing the plans for Seething Lane Garden. We enclose the revised page for inclusion in the planning amendment.

We trust the above is clear.
